A Note from Fr. José Arroyo

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

When I went to World Youth Day in Portugal with our youth and chaperones, we had the privilege of visiting the site where the Fatima children witnessed several apparitions of Our Lady, particularly in Cova Da Iria, (the civil parish of Fatima) within the District of Santarem District. Another great privilege that we had as pilgrims of the same Diocese was the celebration of the Holy Mass presided by our bishop in Santarem at the site of a Eucharistic miracle. As I have reflected on these extraordinary circumstances of the past, it is tempting to limit God's power to the past and forget how active the Lord is in the present moment. Six days after we visited Fatima, a young pilgrim from Madrid, Spain was cured from her blindness after receiving Holy Communion. She and her loved ones were praying a Novena to Our Lady of the Snows for the healing of her eyesight. After praying faithfully for nine days, she went to Mass in Fatima on the memorial of Our Lady of Snows, and she had not yet regained her vision. She entered Mass blind. She received Holy Communion blind. She knelt to make a prayer of thanksgiving for receiving the Eucharist and after she cried out of disappointment, miraculously she began to see. She could see the altar, the tabernacle, her family, and friends. She was able to read again, including the novena prayer they had all been praying all along. This was a reminder to me that God is real and that Our Lady is real and attentive to our needs as a loving mother. I also remembered that we placed at the feet of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima all the petitions that were placed in our prayer box from our parishioners. One of the graces that I received was the opportunity to encounter once again Sr. Angela, the Vice Postulator for the Cause of Canonization of Venerable Lucia of Fatima and the Postulator for Saints Jacinta and Francisco Marto. She sent a brief video to our 13-year-old parishioner who is battling cancer. Although an immediate physical miracle has not occurred, spiritual growth has been made and for this we are grateful.

As we approach the beginning of a new religious education year, we are blessed to have a team of volunteers and staff who have worked immensely to provide a very promising Youth Formation Program. We are praying for a Director of Youth Faith Formation who will be on the parish staff. He or she will direct the teams that will help coordinate the formation of our children from Pre-K to Confirmation on the one hand, and another team that will help coordinate the ongoing formation of the youth who have received their Confirmation. on the other hand. Thanks to all who have responded with generosity by committing to donate of your precious time, talents, and treasures for the glory of God and the service of God's Kingdom in a selfless manner!!!
