How can you help?

- 1. Take a baby bottle from the crib in the Narthex.
- 2. Fill it with loose change (or bills or checks!).
- 3. Return it to the church no later than Sunday, May 5th.

All funds collected will go directly to BABE of Whitley Count in support of their

life-affirming mission.

BABE of Whitley County is an incentivebased program that helps pregnant women and families with young children. When a woman finds out she's pregnant, she can start earning BABE coupons at her prenatal appointments, birth planning appointments, ultrasounds, etc.

Once a baby is born, baby will earn coupons at well-child appointments, immunizations, trips to the library, child development appointments, etc. BABE also hosts classes at its facility so families learn important parenting and life skills and earn coupons!

BABE has created a HUGE community of moms at BABE to support each other, because being a mom is hard and having a support system is what every mom needs. Once families have their BABE coupons, they can redeem them for free diapers, wipes, pull-ups, clothing, strollers, car seats, cribs, travel systems, baby accessories, etc. There are no income guidelines at BABE, they want every family to use BABE! They want all families to take their children to the doctor, and the library, and educate themselves as much as possible.

Given that Indiana ranks 9th in the country for infant mortality rate and 10th for maternal death rate, it's more important than ever that moms and families are utilizing these services.

In 2023 BABE had 313 new clients utilize BABE services, a dramatic increase! BABE has added new coupon providers for families to earn coupons at, including homeschooling co-ops, preschool programs,

and early childhood programs.
BABE of Whitley County relies heavily on

generous donors in the community and appreciates your help! Filling a baby bottle with loose change is an easy way for you and your family to help BABE to provide their help life-affirming services.
