Catholic Q&A

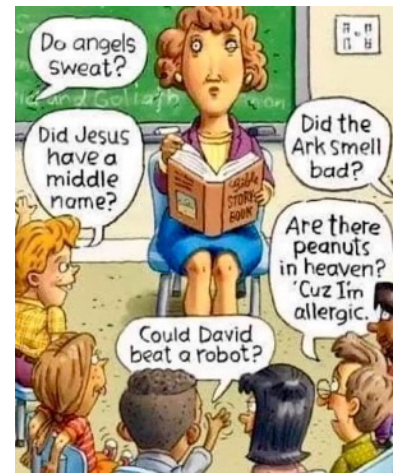

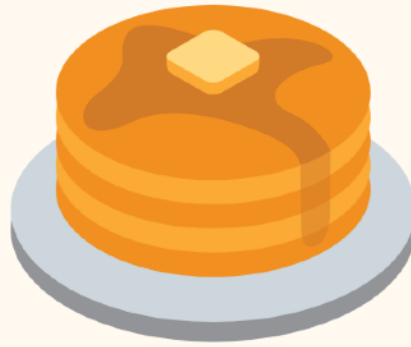
